## EVENT CAMPING RULES

July 20, 2010

Camping spaces are available on a first-come, first served basis, dependent on event reservation structure, the date payment is received, number of nights reserved, and size of RV unit. **THERE ARE ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS FOR CAMPING FOR ANY REASONS. FAIRGROUNDS CAMPING IS NOT RELATED TO ANY EVENT CANCELTATION.**

There will be no helmet enforcement for 4-wheelers, scooters, golf carts, etc. All drivers of 4-wheelers, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters and any other motorized vehicle must have a valid state drivers license in order to operate a motorized vehicle on the Fairgrounds.

For general safety purposes there is a speed limit of **5 miles per hour** for all motorized vehicles (4-wheelers, golf carts, motorcycles, etc.). Anyone found to be breaking the speed limit will be asked to park their vehicle; may be cited; and may be required to leave the Fairgrounds if such conduct continues. In such situations refunds WILL NOT be issued. **There will also be restricted driving times and areas. Please pay attention to all posted signs.**

**Alcohol may only be consumed by those 21 years of age or older in designated camping areas.** Alcohol **may not** be carried from campsites onto public areas including paved walkways, food court, entertainment stage and buildings.

**No open Fires** allowed anywhere on grounds. You may use barbeques and other devices that contain fires but open pit fires are **not** allowed. For smokers please use caution with cigarette butts. We have placed buckets throughout the grounds for your use.

There is a **1:00 a.m. quiet-time** to respect fellow campers and neighbors. Campers will need to have music volumes low enough that it can not be heard outside of their specific site. Conversation volumes must also be kept low. Fair Staff, Fair Board, and/or Grays Harbor County Deputies have the authority to shut down camps or require campers to leave grounds, if necessary. In such situations refunds WILL NOT be issued.

**All dogs must be on leashes or contained in kennel type devices.**

Grays Harbor County Fair & Event Center may in its discretion, restrict, prohibit or shut down campsites that it considers to be unsafe or otherwise inappropriate for fairgrounds events. Persons may be required to leave the grounds for conduct issues and/or inappropriate behavior. No refunds will be issued.

Lanes between rows of camping units must remain open at all times for emergency access and fire protection. Vehicles blocking emergency access will be towed away at owner's expense.

The Grays Harbor County Fairgrounds assumes no responsibility for the security of campsites.

These camping rules are for the protection of our customers as well as to assist personnel in the operation of our grounds. Completion of the Camping Reservation Form and payment constitutes acceptance of the foregoing rules by the adult in charge, as well as all other persons using the assigned camp area.

Camping rates and reservation policies are different for the week of the Grays Harbor County Fair, The World of Outlaws/Big E Race Weekend and all other major event dates. The Fairgrounds reserves the right to modify camping rates, policies and rules as necessary according to the special needs of each event.
