CAMPING RULES – World of Outlaws

Spaces will be 18' front and will be assigned by the Fair Office on a first-come, first served basis, dependent upon returning reservations, the date payment received, number of nights reserved, and size of unit on the Reservation for Camping Space, accompanied by the appropriate fees. Each space will be allowed one vehicle if it fits in space. Added vehicles may be parked in parking lot with purchase of parking pass.

There will be no helmet enforcement for 4-wheelers, scooters, golf carts, etc. However, we do strongly encourage the use of helmets by children. If your child needs a helmet we have free helmets courtesy of the Grays Harbor County Sheriffs Department. Check with Fair Staff or Sheriffs for your free helmet.

There is a speed limit of **5 miles per hour** for all vehicles, 4-wheelers, scooters, golf carts, etc. For the safety of others we will be monitoring the speed limit. Anyone found to be breaking the speed limit will be asked to park their vehicle. **There will also be restricted driving times and areas.** **Please pay attention to all posted signs.**

Alcohol must be consumed in campsites only. Outside alcohol may not be brought into the grandstands. Alcohol may not be carried from campsites onto public areas including paved walkways, food court, entertainment stage and buildings.

No open Fires allowed anywhere on grounds. You may use barbeques and other devices that contain fires but no open pit fires are allowed. For smokers please use caution with cigarette butts. We have placed buckets throughout the grounds for your use.

There is a **1:00 a.m. quiet-time** to respect fellow campers and neighbors. Campsites will need to have all loud music off and keep conversations low. Fair Staff, Fair Board, and/or Grays Harbor County Deputies will be on the grounds all night and will have the authority to shut down camps as necessary.

All dogs must be on leashes or contained.

Grays Harbor County Fair & Event Center may in its discretion, restrict, prohibit or shut down campsites that it considers to be unsafe or otherwise inappropriate for fairgrounds events.

Lanes between rows of camping units must remain open at all times for emergency access and fire protection. Vehicles blocking emergency access will be towed away at owner's expense.

The fair assumes no responsibility for the security of the campground area.

Camping units are not allowed prior to Thursday, September 3, beginning at noon and continuing until 6:00 p.m.

These camping rules are for your protection as well as to provide emergency information and location for Fair Personnel. Completion of the Reservation for Camping Space and payment thereof constitutes acceptance of the foregoing rules by the adult in charge and all persons using the assigned area.
